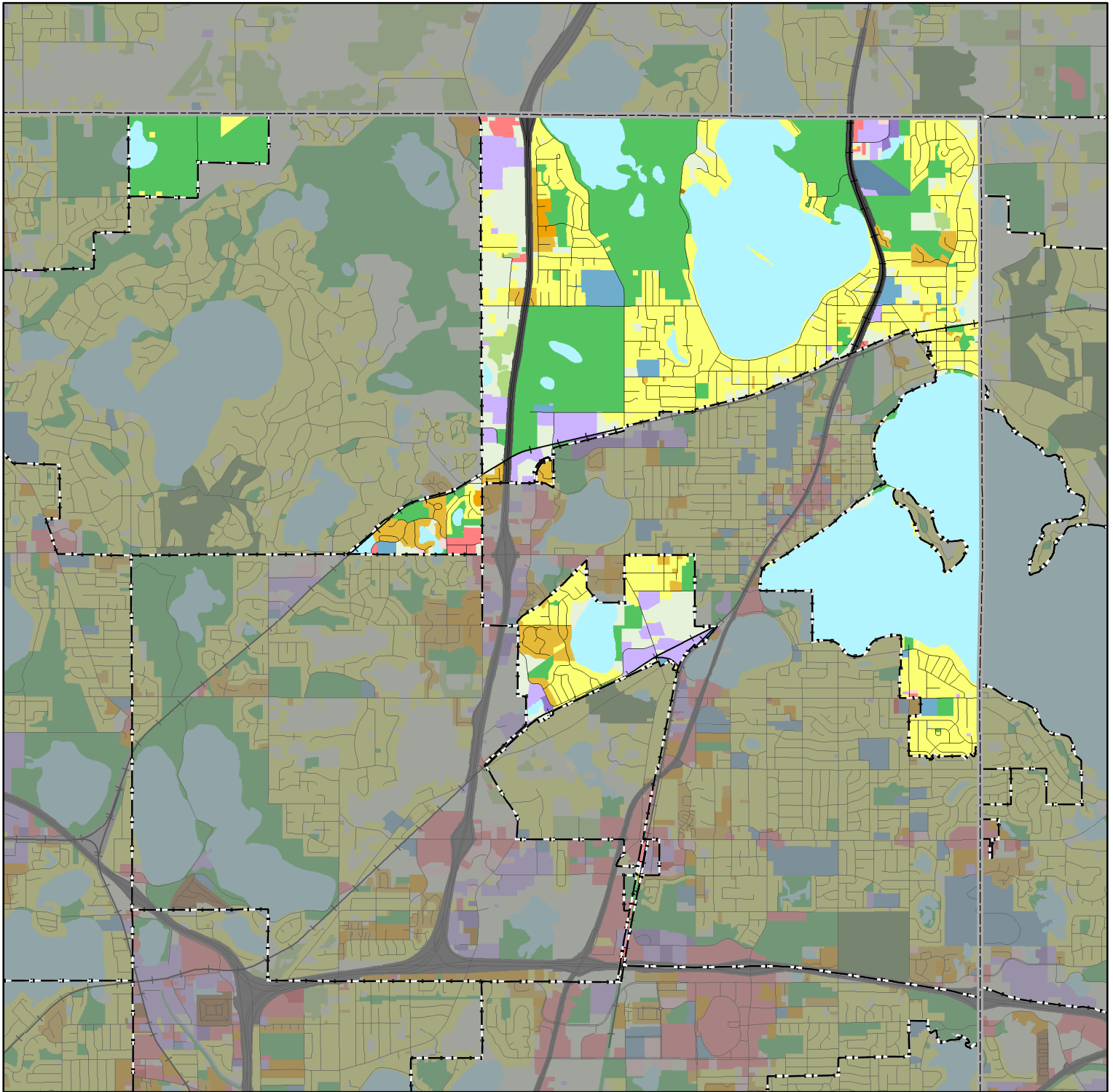


# 2016 Generalized Land Use White Bear Township
